Operation



Arm

Press the arm button to arm the system before leaving your home, arming LED (left) flashes once. any detectors (in Normal Zone)

Disarm

Press the disarm button before entering your home, disarming LED (right) flashes once. Then you are able to move freely in your home without



triggering the alarm. In the event of alarm, you can press this button to neously calls the preset phone numbers. disarm the system and silence the siren.



Mute Mode

Press stay arm button, then press arm or disarm button within 3 seconds to enter into arming or disarming state in mute mode without disturbing someone



Emergency Call

Once there's an emergency situation, no matter what state the alarm system is in, press SOS button once for help, both LED flashes



once, the system immediately goes into an alarm condition and notify your family.



Stay Arm (Home Mode)

Press the stay button, arming LED (left) flashes once, the siren beeps once, system is in stay arm mode. The accessories in home



mode are disarmed, this allows the user to move freely at home, while the rest of the system is fully armed, the accessories in normal zones will activate an immediate alarm when triggered.

WARNING – KEEP BUTTON BATTERIES OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

- If swallowed a lithium button battery may to lead to serious or fatal injury in as little as 2

 battery can still be dangerous even when it can no longer operate the device.
- As soon as you have finished using a button battery, put sticky tape around both sides of it.
 This will make it harder for children to swallow the button battery and avoid the risk of the battery catching fire.
- Immediately dispose of button batteries immediately out of reach of children, or recycle
 using a child resistant container and take used cells to your local battery collection centre.
